CLUB TRÉSORS DE CHAMPAGNE
SPECIAL CLUB CHAMPAGNE

Established in 1971 and officially known as Club de Trésors or Club of Treasures, Special Club Champagne is the highest tier of classification that grower Champagnes can achieve. It is indeed the prestige Cuvée amongst growers. Set up by a group of like-minded wine professionals and enologists, these members work rigorously in assessing quality amongst certain growers in Champagne and finding the best of the best amongst them. Only members can use the dedicated green Special Club bottles for these selected top notch Champagnes.

Pierre Gimonnet Chouilly Grand Cru 2015 is a very limited, single-terroir Blanc de Blancs Champagne made by a grower who specialises in Chardonnay. This very rare cuvée, has a very pleasing floral, minerality about it.

12th generations of growers since 1750, as a 4th generation winemaker Cedric Moussé has adopted an organic approach with the belief of "vinification happens with least possible intervention". Moussé Fils is the first member of Club de Trésors to make a 100% Pinot Meunier for the Spécial Club, which is also true for their rosé champagne. Using the Rosé de Saignée method provides depth and vibrancy to the champagne.
